Your manuscript must have a minimum word count of 40,000 words, and be set in 1.5-spaced, 12-point type, with the manuscript title and page number on every page. Your name must not appear anywhere on the manuscript.

To submit your entry, email info@scribepub.com.au with the following attached as **Word documents or RTFs**:

- your full manuscript
- a synopsis of your manuscript (up to 300 words)
- an author bio (up to 50 words).

Entries open: 1 August 2010

Entries close: 15 September 2010.

Terms and Conditions: Entries must follow the submission guidelines as stated on the entry form. Entrants must be at least 35 years old as of the closing date (i.e. not born after 15 September 1975), and be permanent residents of Australia. Entrants must submit their real name alongside any pen name they may wish to use. Each entrant may only submit one manuscript for consideration. The manuscript must be written in English, complete, original and a work of fiction for an adult or a young-adult readership. No more than ten per cent of the manuscript may have been previously published (in print or electronic form) on a commercial basis. While previously published authors are eligible for this competition, any submitted manuscript must not be under consideration by any other publisher, or for any other competition, until the longlist is announced. Entrants must notify Scribe Publications immediately if their manuscript ceases to be eligible. Entries must be submitted by email or post and received by 4 pm on 15 September 2010. Hand-delivered entries will not be accepted. Scribe Publications does not take responsibility for any lost, delayed or misdirected entries. Entrants will be notified by email upon receipt of a complete entry. All entries to the competition become the property of Scribe Publications and will not be returned. The \$40 entry fee is non-refundable. Manuscripts will be judged solely on literary merit. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into. A longlist and a shortlist will be announced. The winner will be notified by phone or email. The result will also be announced in February 2011 and on the Scribe Publications website. The winning manuscript will be published by Scribe Publications, with a contract negotiated in line with industry norms. The winner will receive a prize of \$15,000, of which \$8000 constitutes an advance against royalties from sales. The prize is not transferable or redeemable for any other goods or services. Only one prize will be awarded. However, if Scribe Publications decides that none of the entries is worthy of publication, no prize will be awarded. Scribe Publications reserves all worldwide publishing rights to the winning manuscript, as well as to any manuscript in the final longlist (until July 2011).
